

# The Yasuni-ITT Initiative

- Scheme to raise money from rich countries to compensate for oil moratorium

- "It was not charity that we sought from the international community, but co-responsibility in the face of climate change



- "Germany will not contribute to a fund that is based on the philosophy of 'payment for non-action'".

Ecuador discouraged potential financial contributors by confused aims and strategies and publicly attacking the UN

There is a need to enhance the effectiveness of the international agenda and impulse market-oriented projects like REDD
