The role of authorship

We want to ask how the role of authorship is changing through AI. On the one hand in science, where both scientific texts, student papers, and research proposals are generated by AI, and on the other hand in art and society, where value has usually been placed on who created a work of art and how the work is related to its creator.

Several guests will share their perspectives from the fields of education, science, and arts. This will be followed by a moderated and interdisciplinary discussion. The panel discussion is framed by an academic conference, but is formally independent of it. The panel discussion is aimed at the general public.
